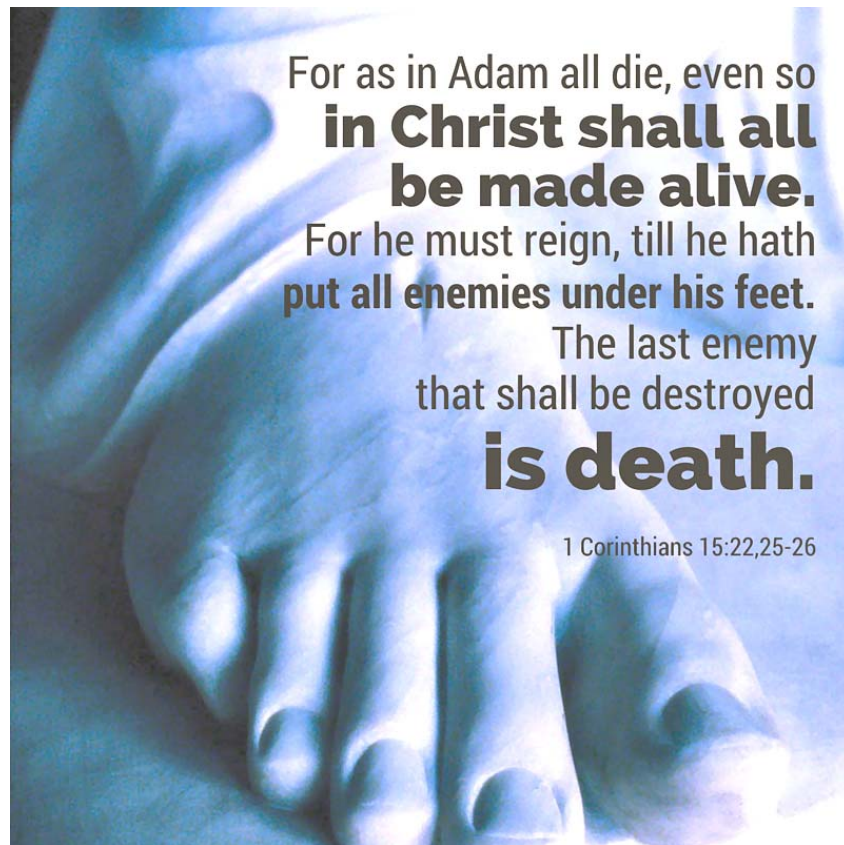

Welcome to Beloit First Christian Church (BFCC)

We are glad you're here and pray you will experience God's presence and love. 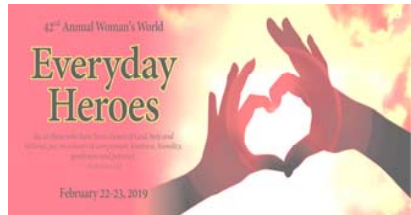

A special message from Elder Board Chairman, Gary Allen:



Dear BFCC Family,

On behalf of the Elders at Beloit First Christian Church I want to extend to you an invitation to continue in prayer and encouragement of our Pastors. Pastors Cliff Heagy, Dave Mealiff and Doug Betts are our front line warriors and teachers in our

mission to partner with God in making and growing disciples for Christ. The Apostle Paul reminds us in Ephesians 6:12 that our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Satan schemes and enjoys nothing more than wearing us out and thwarting our desire to draw near to Christ and our sharing of Jesus' life giving gospel message.

Pastor Cliff has expressed desire to be granted a sabbatical of two months during June and July in order to be still, refresh his spirit and experience direction from God for ministry. The Elders are united in support of Pastor Cliff's request and voted unanimous approval. We view this as an opportunity for our church to grow in new ways, rather than a time of anxiousness or panic. 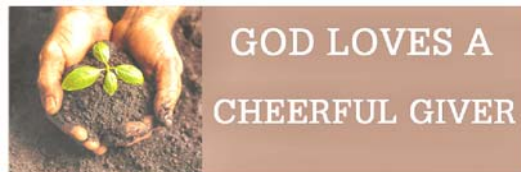
